Motivation

Since learners look to aviation instructors as role models, it is important that instructors not only know how to teach, but that they project a knowledgeable and professional image.

Objective

Understand the importance of projecting a professional image, promoting aviation safety, and acting ethically.

Aviation Instructor Responsibilities

Aviation instructors have a broad set of responsibilities, including:

- Helping learners
- Providing adequate instruction
- Training to established standards of performance
- Emphasizing the positive
- Minimizing learner frustrations





Helping Learners

- Make each lesson a pleasurable experience
- Learners should be challenged and interested
- Understand the learners constraints, worries, and motivations
 - Structure training around those things
- Don't give unfair criticism

Providing Adequate Instruction

- Instruction should be tailored to each learner's personality, thinking, and abilities
- Instruction may need to be:
 - Slower / faster
 - More hands-on / More theoretical
- Some learners may be more quiet and reserved, some more talkative
- Split complex tasks into simpler component tasks

Training to Standards

- Teach to the required standards in the PTS/ACS
- Use the standard as a guide throughout the training to determine objectives
 - Avoid "teaching to the test", however
- Remember: PTS is a testing document, not a teaching document





Emphasizing the Positive

- Conduct yourself with a positive attitude
- Use the fun of flying a tool to motivate students
 - Expose the students to new flying experiences
- Negative self-concept and fear are major barriers to learning

Minimizing Learner Frustrations

- Motivate learners
- Keep learners informed
- Approach learners as individuals
- Give credit when due
- Criticize constructively
- Be consistent
- Admit your own errors
- Maintain a light-hearted tone



Flight Instructor Responsibilities

- Evaluate learner piloting abilities
- Provide pilot supervision
- Make practical test recommendations
- Give endorsements and additional training
- Ensure pilot proficiency
- Maintain see-and-avoid responsibility
- Guide pre-solo flight thought process
- Emphasize special items in the PTS

Flight Instructor Qualifications & Professionalism

- Be very familiar with aircraft and its systems
- Showcase expertise in flying and theory
- Stay current with training techniques and certification requirements
 - Subscribe to publications to get notified of changes
 - Be extra alert for changes to regulations and training standards

Exhibiting Professionalism



- Be sincere
- Accept the learner as they are
- Maintain appropriate personal appearance
- Maintain a professional demeanor
- Use proper language



Professional Development

- Continuously update skills and knowledge
- Avoid complacency
- Seek new ways to improve effectiveness
 - Seek additional training or ratings
 - Opportunities for new experiences

Instructor Ethics & Conduct

Instructor Code of Ethics:

- 1. Make safety the number one priority
- 2. Develop and exercise good judgment in decisions
- 3. Recognize and manage risk effectively
- 4. Be accountable for actions
- 5. Act with responsibility and courtesy
- 6. Adhere to prudent operating practices and personal parameters
- 7. Follow applicable laws and regulations

Fulfilling Instructor Responsibilities

- Continuously evaluate learner ability based on established standards
- Keep learners informed of their progress
 - Use a syllabus and share it with your student
 - Use and continuously update a rubric, also shared with your student
 - Be honest with your students abilities and limitations
